



Ohio Governor Mike DeWine issued a “stay-at-home” order for all Ohioans. This order goes into effect starting at 11:59pm Monday March 23. The following essential activities are permitted.

**Health and safety**

Emergency services, obtaining medical supplies or medication, or visiting a health care profession.

**Necessary supplies and services**

grocery shopping, and shopping for other items necessary for the household, and work from home operations. This includes carryout food.

**Outdoor activity**

Visiting public parks, walking, and biking are permitted as long as people remain 6 feet apart. Playgrounds are closed.

**Essential work**

Healthcare and public health operations, human services operations, government and essential infrastructure operations.

**Care for others**

To care for family, friends, or pets, including transportation, weddings, and funerals.
