

INVITATION TO BID

SEALED BIDS for the furnishing of the necessary materials and construction of the **Tantallon Plat I & Plat II Resurfacing, City of Sylvania, Lucas County, Ohio** will be received by the City of Sylvania, Lucas County, Ohio in the office of the Clerk of Council, City of Sylvania, 6730 Monroe Street, Suite 201, Sylvania, Ohio 43560 until 10:00 a.m., local time, on December 9, 2022, and at that time and place will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The proposed work consists of: Milling and resurfacing the top 2” of asphalt concrete including partial depth pavement repair work in the Tantallon Plat I and Plat II Subdivision. The roadways scheduled to be resurfaced include Burrwood Drive, Dunhill Drive (Centennial Farms to Peppermill Drive), Grenlock Drive (Burrwood Drive to Highland Elementary), Marshwood Drive, Peppermill Drive, Saltwood Court, Shaftesbury Drive, Therfield Drive, and Towbridge Court. The total length of resurfacing is over 6,100 feet.

Copies of the Drawings and Specifications and other Contract Documents **must** be obtained from the City of Sylvania Service Department at 6730 Monroe Street, Suite 101, Sylvania, Ohio upon request of \$10.00 for each set of Contract Drawings, Specifications and Contract Documents. The deposit will not be refunded. Copies may be examined at the above office.

All bids shall be signed and submitted on the blanks which are bound in the bidding documents. Bid blanks must be returned in the bound documents. Bids shall state the unit prices on the blanks provided therefore; shall be enclosed in a sealed envelope marked – **“BID FOR TANTALLON PLAT I & PLAT II RESURFACING”**.

Bids received after the scheduled bid opening date and time will neither be read nor considered and will be returned unopened to the bidder. The City of Sylvania reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any irregularity in any bid, to determine the lowest and best bidder, and to waive any informalities in bidding. The bid guaranty may be of two forms: 1. A Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond using the form in this booklet. (The amount of the bid does NOT have to appear on this form.) 2. A certified check, cashier's check or letter of credit in favor of the City of Sylvania in the amount of 10% of the bid. If the contract is awarded, a Contract Bond will be required, which is a 100% payment and performance bond. Upon acceptance of the work, a one year maintenance bond in the amount of 25% of the contract will be required to guarantee such work. No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 60 days after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids.
