### Items that will be picked up include:

Household rubbish in garbage bags or cans ≤ 40 lbs. per bag/can, furniture, appliances, televisions, mattresses, box springs, bicycles, carpet (Rolls must be ≤ 4 ft. wide x 18 in. in diameter, rolled and tied/ taped) Wood that is no longer than 4ft in length and tied in 40 lbs. bundles - all nails/screws must be removed or pounded down. Appliances with Freon (refrigerators, freezers, A/Cs, dehumidifiers) MUST include certification that Freon has been removed

This pick up does NOT include Green Yard Waste

# FOR THE SAFETY OF THE WORKERS, PLEASE DO NOT STACK ITEMS ON TOP OF EACH OTHER

#### Some items that will not be picked up include:

Construction materials, drywall, dirt, railroad ties, ceiling tiles, pieces of concrete, posts that have concrete on them, concrete blocks, bricks, large pieces of glass or mirrors, liquids, chemicals, latex paint that is not dried up, empty paint can that has a lid on the can, oil-based paint, batteries, tires, automobile parts, gas cans, pressurized tanks (propane or helium tanks), anything with oil or fuel (lawn mower, snow blower, edger, or trimmer that is not drained and the gas cap removed), pianos, pool tables, boats, fire extinguisher, hazardous materials.

## More Unlimited Pick-Up Guidelines

- No evictions or total move-outs intended for regular household waste
- All loose material must be bagged do not use cardboard boxes
- If you want Republic to dispose of a trash can, label it: "Trash Please Dispose"
- Wooden doors must be cut in half
- Ping pong tables must be broken down
- Glass must be broken, boxed, taped, and labeled "Broken Glass"
- Needles must be in a sealed plastic container, clearly marked
- Toilets must have the tank removed from the base
- Hot tubs & bath tubs must be cut into 4 ft. sections
- Basketball hoops:
  - Remove backboard
  - Cut pole to  $\leq 4$  ft.
  - Drain water/sand from base
